DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From the North: Take State Road 37 South to the first Bloomington exit (Walnut Street/College Avenue). Proceed 0.6 mile to the second stoplight. Turn left on State Road 45/46 and drive 0.7 mile to the second stoplight. Turn right onto Fee Lane. Proceed south on Fee Lane for approximately 0.5 mile to the next stoplight. Turn left at the light onto 17th Street. As you reach the crest of the hill (0.3 mile), turn right onto Jordan Avenue. Follow Jordan through two stoplights and a stop sign. Continue straight through the stop sign and up the hill. The MAC will be on your right at the top of the hill.

From the Northwest: Follow State Road 46 into Bloomington. Continue to follow State Road 46 into Bloomington, turn right on Fee Lane. Follow the North directions from this point on.

From the East: On State Road 46, you will enter Bloomington's residential and shopping area; State Road 46 becomes East Third Street. Continue straight through the traffic signal on East Third Street. Continue on East Third Street through two stoplights. At the third stoplight, turn right onto Jordan Avenue. The MAC will be on your left.

From the West or Southwest: Take State Road 45 or 48 to State Road 37. Turn left onto State Road 37 and continue north to State Road 46. Turn right onto State Road 46. At the fourth stoplight, turn right onto Fee Lane. Follow the North directions from this point on.

From the South: Take State Road 37 until you reach the intersection of State Road 37 and State Road 46. Turn right onto the 46 bypass and continue to the fourth stoplight. Follow North directions from this point on.

Sign-In takes place at the Musical Arts Center (MAC). **We recommend that you arrive well in advance of your first scheduled event to check-in.** At that time, you will receive your audition room assignment as well as practice room information. The MAC is the point from which all tests, auditions, tours, and information sessions originate.

Please note that the MAC will close when registration ends at 4:00 p.m. on Friday and at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday. Please make arrangements to meet with your families and friends in Clouse's Lounge located in the Merrill Hall music building lower level.

PARKING

Drivers may pull into the half circle drive in front of the MAC to drop students off but no parking, including temporary, is allowed. Convenient parking is available in the Jordan Parking Garage, one block north of the MAC on the east side of Jordan Avenue. Included in this packet is a yellow parking permit. You may use this to park in the Jordan Garage at no charge.
